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As a supporter of OUCH (UK) you will know how hard we work to ensure that every penny we raise goes as far as it can. Through Gift Aid, you can help us make your donations go 28% further and it won't cost you a penny!

How does it work?

So long as you are a UK taxpayer, Gift Aid enables you to boost the value of your donations by as much as 28p for every £1 you give. For example, if you decide to give £10 to OUCH (UK) we will be able to claim an extra £2.80 from HM Revenue & Customs. This applies to membership subscriptions/renewals as well as donations. What is more, if you are a higher rate taxpayer, you are entitled to claim tax relief on your donations, enabling you to reclaim as much as 23p from every £1 donated to charity.

What do you need to do?

To donate through Gift Aid, all you need to do is complete the form below. Just one declaration can apply to all donations that you have made to us over the past 6 years and to any forthcoming gifts you make, until you notify us otherwise.
